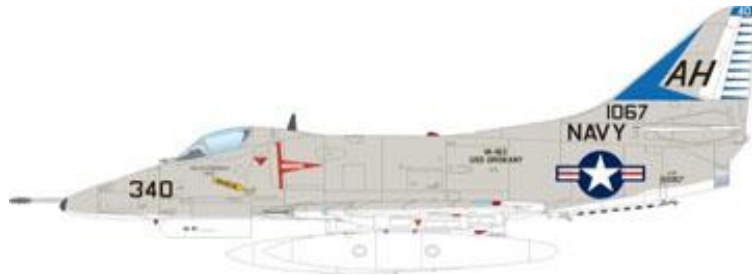

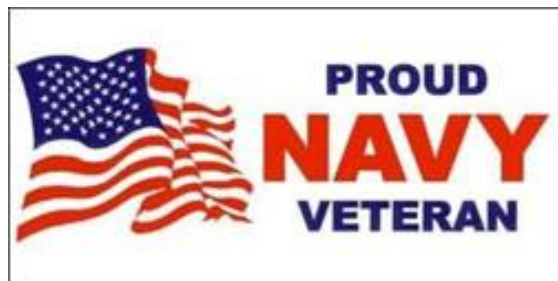

Capt. Bert H. Creighton, Jr., U.S. Navy (ret.) of Coronado, passed away on **10 Dec 2007** at home. He was born in Richmond, VA to parents Alma Davis Creighton and Bert H. Creighton, Sr. His father was Naval Aviator #1016. He joined the Navy during World War II and entered an aviation program, earning his Wings of Gold. He was attached to fighter and attack squadrons, rising to the rank of captain and earning the Navy's Bronze Star among other awards. He was one of the Navy's first jet pilots and served as the **Executive Officer** of several squadrons including **VA-163**, VX-4 and VX-5. He earned a bachelor's degree in Civil War naval history. While serving his country he was pleased most by the respect he received from the people with whom he worked. He loved flying, especially in the Navy's Bearcat and Skyhawk. He retired after 32 years of naval service and then successfully owned and operated an antiques and estate sale business with his wife. He will be remembered for his dedication to his country and his family. All who knew him respected him and loved him for his kindness, generosity and warmth. He is survived by his wife of 54 years Olga Creighton; his son Bert H. Creighton III (Ty;)

his daughter Virginia; his daughter Shirli; his daughter-in-law Deidra; and six grandchildren Chris, Brendan, Julia, Gregory, Alex and Samantha. A private interment ceremony is planned for immediate family at the Ft. Rosecrans National Cemetery. A memorial service and reception will be held on Dec. 28 at 1 p.m. at North Island. In lieu of flowers, memorial contributions may be made to a charity of your choice or Operation Homefront that supports military families, a cause that was close to Creighton's heart. Here are updated links to all of the Saints interviews. They might help give some direction on where we want to go, or jar some remembrances. Feel free to share them. Also, a reminder that Hook '21 is focusing on the Vietnam Air Campaign. "Lady Jessie, A Vietnam Story" is kicking off the event, with a Q & A panel featuring some VA 164 members and Saint Ken Adams. There will also be a second, more casual break out session - essentially time to "talk story."

It would be great if any VA-163 guys felt like making the trip. We had a virtual meeting yesterday, and it was clear that the goal of Hook '21 is to honor those who served during Vietnam, and weave that thread that connects the warriors of that era to the warriors of today. 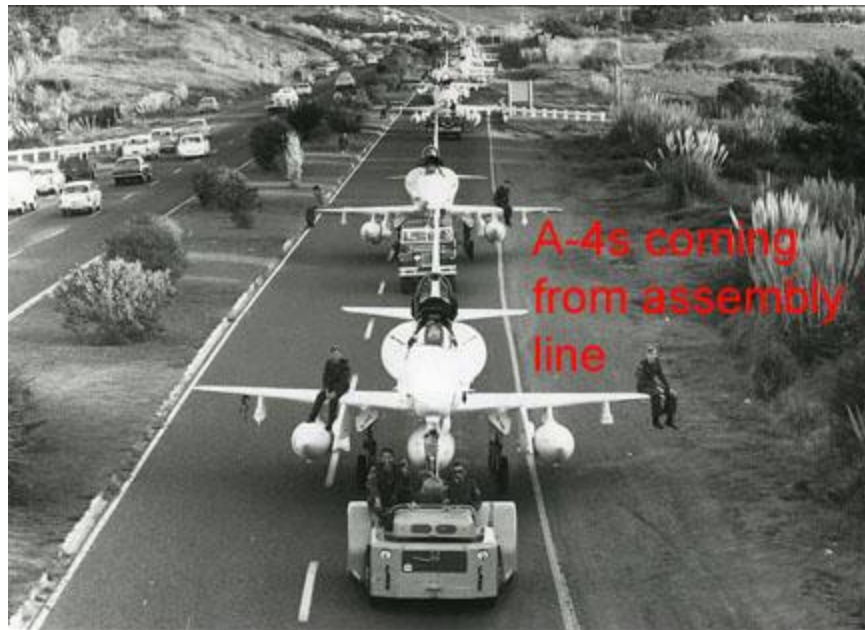

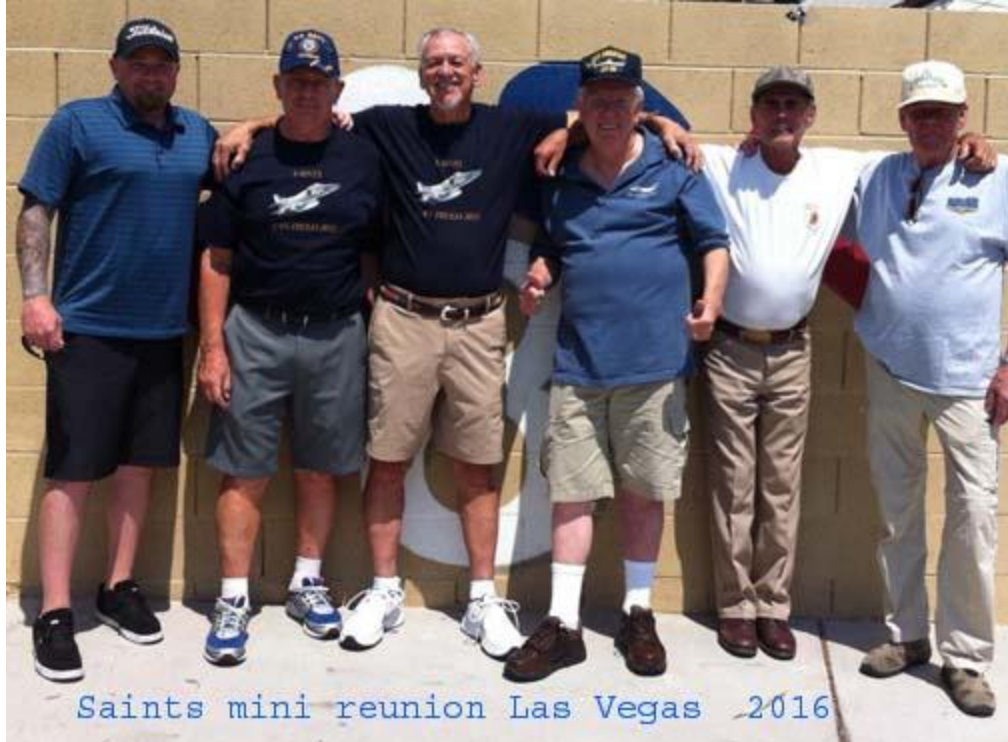

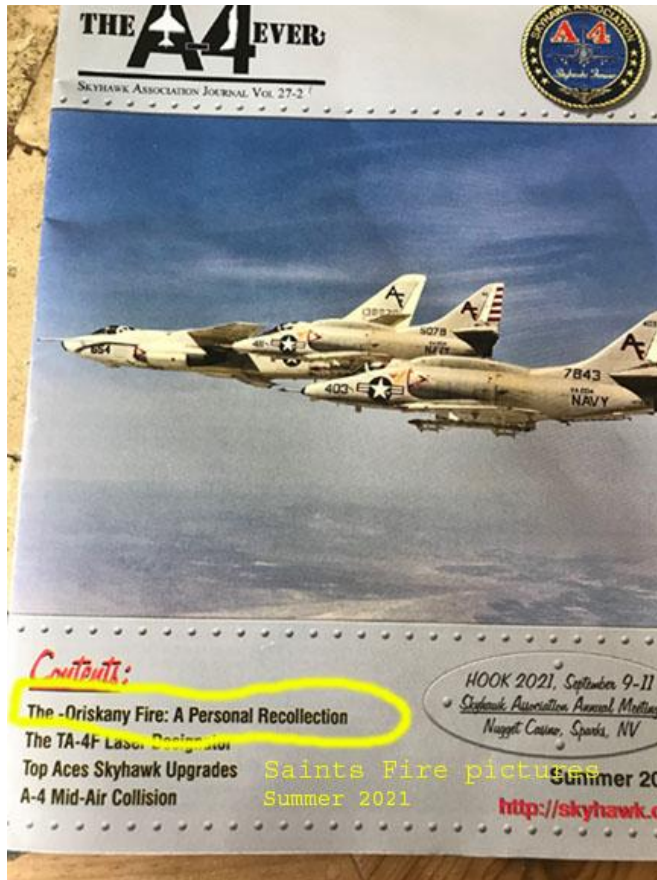
